# WHAT TO DO IN SEPTEMBER

- Plant Summer vegetable varieties in your veggie patch such as Chillies, Peppers, Tomatoes, Patty Pans, Baby Sweetcorns, Cucumbers, Squash, Pumpkins, Beans and Aubergines. For a 6 week head start we stock **organic seedlings** for your health. For the seed enthusiast we offer a wide range of **Starke Ayres Vegetable Seed** to choose from such as the **NEW Salad Mix** packs and our **Spring Promo Packs** with a range of vegetable seed packets containing **20% FREE seed**.
- Plant a hanging basket. If you're short on space in your garden, hanging baskets and pots are the easiest fix. Add **Vermiculite** or **Palm Peat** to pots to help with the water retention.
- Deadhead your pansies and violas, so that they can continue to flower right into Summer. Continue feeding with an organic liquid fertiliser such as **Sea Secret, Starke Ayres Nutrifeed, Nitrosol** or a granular **3:1:5 Organic** or chemical.
- **Clivias** commonly known as bush lilies bring spectacular colour to any shady area of your garden during the month of September. They are not just easy to care for but are indigenous and waterwise. **Rhaphiolepis** are tough, wind resistant, low maintenance shrubs and bloom prolifically in late September and October.
- **Plant a tree during Arbor month. Fruit trees** do not only offer shade, but will reward you with fruit during season. Spray fruit trees with **Kombat Fruitfly** early in the morning to avoid bees (so you're bee-friendly and not end up killing any bees) once 80% of the petals have dropped. **A lemon tree** is a 12 month asset to all gardens. Easy to grow in soil or a container. Please see our new posters in our fruit tree area.
- Lawns require a boost in Spring. Apply **Talborne Organics 2:3:2** on lawns that are in bad condition to promote root growth. Healthy lawns require a bit of a boost, apply **Talborne Organics 5:1:5** or any **3:1:5** every 2-3 months. Water well after each application.
- Prune Spring flowering shrubs when they have finished flowering. Continue feeding throughout Spring and Summer with fertilisers high in nitrogen and potassium such as **Talborne Organics 6:3:4**.
- Feed roses with **3:1:5 Organic** throughout the growing season.
