


100 % Food Grade Diatomaceous Earth

INNOVATIVE GARDENING SOLUTIONS

- DIATOMACEOUS EARTH -

PEST CONTROL APPLICATION METHOD:

DRY APPLICATION: Use hand or power duster, or other suitable means, to apply to cracks, crevices, voids, hiding and runway areas, plants/lawns and places where pests are found.

WET APPLICATION: Fill a garden sprayer with 100g/Litre water and shake to mix well. Add a few drops of liquid dish soap to help suspend the particles in the water. Spray the lawn, foundations, fences, trees, pet enclosures and anywhere that fleas, ticks, ants and other insects may congregate. Shake the sprayer often to keep the powder suspended for even coverage. Expect a white coating wherever you spray after the solution dries.

LAWNS & PLANTS: *Dry application:* Wet the lawns/plants with fine mist of water and spread DE liberally either by hand or using a duster.

Wet application: The goal is to get coverage over the entire plant, especially under the leaves.

ANTS: Apply to cracks, crevices and voids where insects may be harboring, traveling, breeding or entering the structure. If possible, apply dust into infested wood through existing openings or newly drilled small holes.

FLEAS: Massage into pet's coat, specifically in hard to reach areas e.g. top of head, around neck, ridge of back, base of tail and stomach groin area. Safe to use weekly or as needed.

BED BUGS: Apply at a minimum rate of 50g/10m² to cracks, crevices and voids associated with mattresses, box springs, bed frames and other furniture where these insects may harbor, travel, breed or enter the room.

CAUTION:

Avoid contact with eyes. If in eyes: Rinse eyes thoroughly with water.
